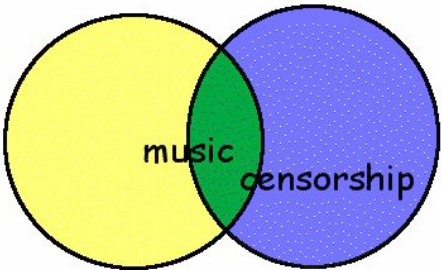
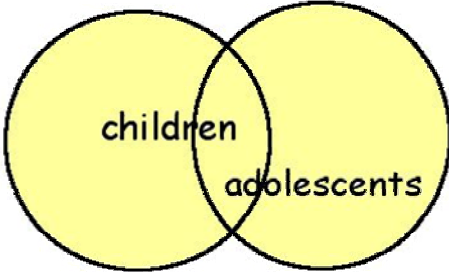
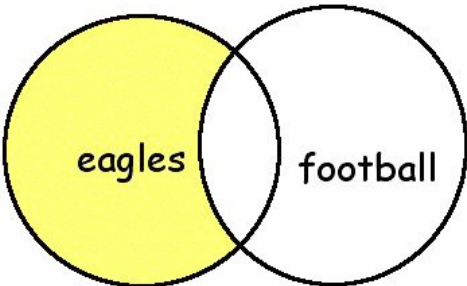

**Query or Search Strategies**

<p><b>AND</b></p> 	<p><b>OR</b></p>  <p><b>OR is generally used for synonyms or related words</b></p>
<p><b>NOT</b></p>  <p>Eagles NOT Philadelphia "Martin Luther" NOT King</p>	<p><b>"Phrase searching"</b></p>

**Stop using *stop words* in your searches!**

in, of, the, a, to you, why,  
who, what, on, than, then,  
their, an, his, her, be

**A question is not a query:**

<p>How many buffalo are in the U.S? What are famous landmarks in Peru?</p>	<p>Can you create an effective "two word" search?</p>

**Helpful hints for searching:**

- Brainstorm several **key words** and phrases—the ones you think would appear and wouldn't appear in your dream document
- Look for better words and phrases as you search
- Include most important words and phrases first.
